WSrC 2017 Information

Dear friends,

Only a few days are left until the arrival of 44 delegations from all over the world to Germany to the World Senior Championships 2017. We look very much forward to the participation of your team and your delegates.

The following current information shall make their arrival and their stay in Munich/Unterföhring as convenient as possible.

1. Flags / Anthems

Flags and anthems will be available on site. There is no need for your teams to bring flags or anthems with them.

2. Oil patterns / Lane map guide

World Bowling has selected the [bank of patterns](#) to be Bank 2 (formerly Medium). The Pattern itself as well as a Lane Map Guide of the competition lanes will be presented at the Team Managers Meeting on 13th August.

3. Arrivals at Munich airport

Pick-ups will be provided on both arrival days mentioned in the bulletin, i.e. on 12th and 13th August. The attached document shows the arrival times and the number of persons registered for this service. Please check this information carefully and submit any changes and corrections to 2017WSrC@worldbowling.org immediately.

Please inform your delegations that they will meet our driver at the "Munich Airport Center" between Terminals 1 and 2, right in front of McDonald's (from arrival gates, follow signs to the area Z). 4. Arrivals by own car / parking options

Each of the official hotels offers a parking garage at various fees. Free outside parking is possible at the Park Inn hotel, subject to availability. Dream-Bowl Palace offers to keep cars in their garage during the WSrC at a reduced rate of 2 Euro per night. This special rate does also apply when entering and leaving again on the same day. In both cases, pick a regular ticket when entering the garage and present it to the counter at the bowling centre before leaving to the garage again.

5. Check-In procedure

An information desk will be set up next to the bowling centre counter to be available from 12th to 20th August during all activities presented in the WSrC schedule. Our staff will be glad to assist you with all questions that your team might have about the event itself as well as about tourist information, medical service etc.

We kindly ask all Team Managers to pick up some material from this desk soonest possible on 12th August or 13th August (open from 10 AM to 6 PM on both days). This material will include program books, WSrC passports and gift vouchers for the whole team. When doing so, please present passports or ID cards for all registered players in order to check their eligibility of participation with regard to nationality and the date of birth.

During check-in, all Team Managers will be asked to confirm the number of participants in the Farewell Banquet on 20th August as well as the departure times for their teams in order to prepare the airport transfer schedule for 21st August.

6. Shuttle service during the event

A shuttle service will be provided between Dream-Bowl Palace and the official hotels from 12th August to 20th August according to the attached schedule. This schedule can be subject to changes at any time if necessary. The current schedule will always be available at the information desk in the bowling centre as well as at all official hotels.

Please understand that usage of the shuttle service is restricted to players, officials and supporters that have been registered. All passengers will be required to present their tournament passports to the driver when entering the bus. For security reasons, the drivers may deny access at their discretion in case of capacity overload.

7. Live Scoring / Streaming

Both Live Scoring and Live Streaming will be available through links on the WSrC website www.bowling-wm.de from 14th to 20th August.

8. Public Holiday on 15th August

Please inform your teams that Tuesday 15th August is a public regional holiday in the Munich area. Shops will be closed like on Sundays.

9. Outstanding Hotel fees

The following federations have not yet paid the full amount of their hotel fees and / or bank charges have been deducted from your payment: Bolivia, Columbia, Dominican Republic, New Zealand, Paraguay, Puerto Rico, Saudi-Arabia, South Africa, USA, Venezuela, Wales.

Please make sure that the remainder of all fees will be paid in Euro cash only to Florian Fister right after the Team Managers Meeting on 13th August.

10. Outstanding Registration fees

Any federation that has not paid their athlete, coach, administrator and registered supporter fees prior to arrival in Munich must make such payment in cash prior to the Official Practice; these may be paid either in Euros or US dollars.

11. Ball Registration Procedure

Please pay attention to the email sent by World Bowling on 28th July with regard to ball registration. Pay special attention to the fact that you have to fill in all requested information about each ball. So far, many federations have registered balls with their name only, but not given the serial number and other requested information.

No ball inspection will take place prior to the event. It is the responsibility of the players and federations to register balls which fulfil and meet the requirements.

12. Official Practice Schedule

World Bowling is about to prepare the schedule for the Official Practice on 14th August. It will be available at the website www.bowling-wm.de soonest possible, latest by Saturday 12th August.
